Based on the observation that environmental causes are not sufficiently addressed in the study of diseases, especially cancer, we took the initiative to create in Brussels an international network of researchers interested in that question.

The European Research Institute on Cancer and the Environment (ECERI) is a research organization federating scientific international units and research centers that have decided to devote part of their research activities to the environment as a cause of diseases, and that have agreed to share their expertise and skills.

The objective of the ECERI network--designed to be of a very high scientific level, and therefore supported by several American scientists and Nobel Prize winners--is to obtain significant funding from national and European Union authorities, for research on specific programs in this neglected area that is of common interest to the network.
